In a remarkable career that spanned 46 years, Abbe mentored generations of scientists responsible for modern meteorology. 

They were aware of the progression of liberty throughout English history. This discussion will progress through the five major documents from the 12th -17th century including references from the Book-- "Not a Living Breathing Document" by Krisanne Hall. Covered will be documents addressing the following: 1) Liberties contained in the DOI and USC, 2) True meaning of the separation of church and state, 3) Limitations to the king's ability to tax, 4) Establishment of taxation only through a "representative council, 5) Rights to "due process" and "speedy trial", 6) Martial law cannot be imposed in times of peace, and troops cannot be quartered without consent of resident, 7) Prevention of infiltration of foreign laws.


Meet the Opinion Editor of the Cincinnati Enquirer
